## What makes a Trained Leader?

New BSA initiatives will soon be coming which requires that all contact leaders complete training for their position. In September we will begin to examine personal training records of top unit leaders to begin our quest toward the goal of having 100% trained leaders. We are aware that the computer tracking system currently in place has its faults and we will be working to see if we can correct some of those issues before contacting the top unit leaders with regard to their training status. This first round will include Cubmasters, Scoutmasters, and Crew Advisors.

### **Troop Committee Members**

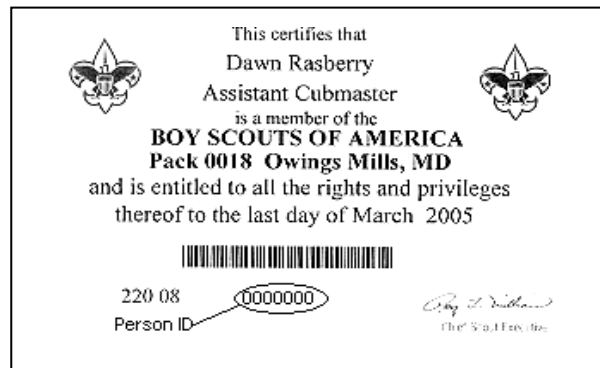

# On-Line Training

The on-line learning center site provides a variety of materials, from quick references to complete courses, all designed to help our members improve leadership skills and deliver a quality program. These courses can help adult leaders deliver quality Scouting experiences to youth. A login is required; however anyone may create a user account and view the courses. Registered members of the BSA must provide their member numbers (as part of the user profile) to receive credit. If you are a registered member of the BSA, please submit a person ID to ensure your training record is updated.



Your person ID can be found on the bottom of your membership card. If you do not have your membership card, your registration number can be obtained from your unit leader (included on the roster printout) or the council registrar at (608) 273-1005.

Once your member number is entered into your “myscouting” account, it is linked to your council training records. You can use the “training validation” tab to see all the trainings you have attended and the dates you completed them.
