  - Monday, Tuesday, June 18 & 19 at Token Creek County Park



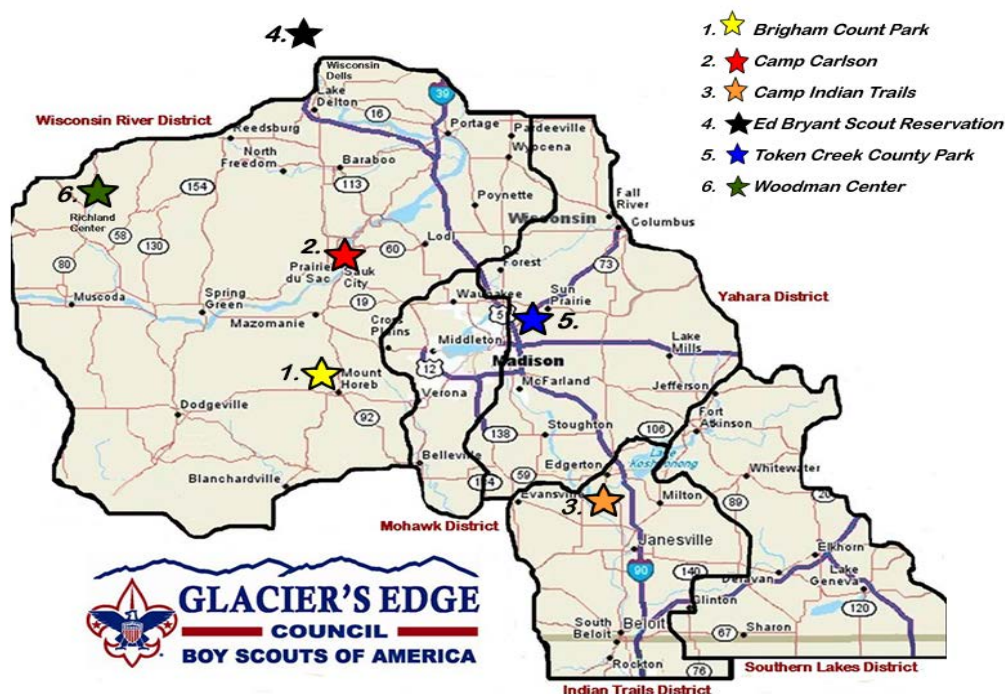
## Cub Scout Day Camp

- Options for overnight pack camping will be available at Brigham, Token Creek, and Camp Indian Trails
  - Brigham County Park – June 15-16 (Friday –Saturday)
  - Token Creek County Park – June 18-20 (Monday –Wednesday)
  - Camp Carlson – June -22-23 (Friday – Saturday)
  - District Day Camp at Camp Indian Trails– July 1 (Sunday)
  - Camp Indian Trails (Tuesday – Friday , add additional day for optional overnight Friday evening and Saturday morning)
    - June 19 – 22, or July 24-27, or August 7-10



## Webelos Shooting Sports

- **Webelos Shooting Sports Camp:** A camp designed for Webelos Scouts. Scouts attending this program will earn the BB gun and archery shooting sports pins. If over registration occurs, Webelos IIs receive preference. Brigham and Token Creek are Twilight Camps
  - Brigham County Park - June 14 – 15 (Thursday-Friday)
  - Token Creek County Park – June 18 – 19 (Monday-Tuesday)
  - Camp Carlson – June 24 (Sunday)

## Resident Camps

### Cub Scout Resident Camp

- Resident camp includes overnight stay.
- Program features shooting sports, waterfront or pool activities, crafts, nature, sports and other activities. Climbing is offered at CIT. Evening campfires will round out the program.

  - Ed Bryant Scout Reservation Boy Scout Preview recommended for Webelos I & II other cubs may attend
    - July 27 – 29 (Fri-Sun)



### Webelos Expedition

- An overnight camp at Ed Bryant Scout Reservation with Webelos appropriate activities. The event is capped off by a very special "Blessing of the Arrows" ceremony to send the Webelos on the final leg of their journey of Cub Scouting and on to their Arrow of Light Award.
- Meals will be provided just bring your tents and personal gear.
  - May 11 – 12 (Friday – Saturday overnight camping Saturday night is optional) This program augments and does not replace summer camp for Webelos. All meals in Fellowship Hall
  - July 6 - 8 (Friday – Sunday) This is special session of Summer Camp. Staffed by the EBSR Summer Staff. All the features of the camp including swimming will be included in the program. Scouts will also prepare at least one meal (food provided)



### Webelos Resident Camp

- Camp Akela at Camp Indian Trails
  - Camp Akela helps Webelos with their journey to becoming a Boy Scout. Campers will work on activity pins and enjoy swimming, shooting sports, climbing and other activities.
  - Stay on site. Campers need to bring their personal gear, clothes, sleeping gear and tents. All meals are provided by the camp.

    - August 2 -5 (Thursday – Sunday)
- Ed Bryant Scout Reservation Boy Scout Preview (Recommended for Webelos I & II other cubs may attend)
  - Stay on site. Campers need to bring their personal gear, clothes, sleeping gear and tents. All meals are provided by the camp.
  - Program features shooting sports, waterfront, crafts, nature, sports and other activities. Evening campfires will round out the program with a Cub attending the Boy Scout Camp closing campfire on Friday and their one Cub Scout campfire on Saturday.
