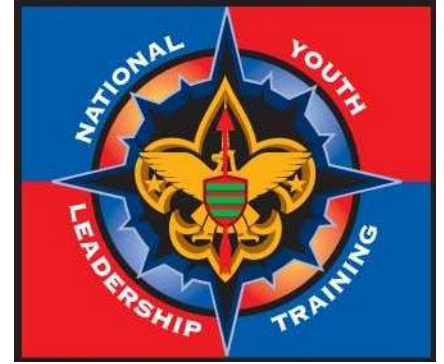

National Youth Leadership Training



Dear Unit Leaders and Committee Chairs:

The training and development of the youth of a crew or troop is very important. It helps both the individual youth and the unit to grow. National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) is offered by the Glaciers Edge Council to assist you in training and developing your top youth leaders.

In response to increasing demand, Glacier's Edge Council has made available a second NYLT course week this year. Space will be limited to the first 48 qualified participants that sign up for each course week. This year our sessions will be held:

Course 1: Monday, June 11th to Saturday, June 16th, 2012

Course 2: Monday, June 25th to Saturday June 30th, 2012

The courses are nationally registered courses and the syllabus for the national BSA course will be followed. Cost of the course is \$185.00.

Members of your unit who currently hold the leadership positions of Senior Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, President, or Vice-President or may hold one of these positions in the future would benefit tremendously and should plan to attend the conference. Our course is open to eligible Scouts and Crew members and will be co-ed. To develop a youth's full potential during NYLT, the youth must have attained a certain maturity and mastered basic camping skills.
